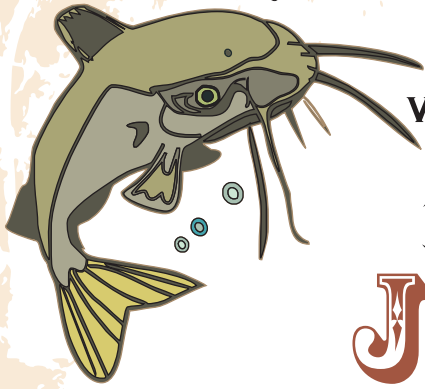

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Any member or team member previously disqualified from any other fishing tournament or disqualified for disorderly or unsportsmanlike conduct, will not be eligible to fish in the Covenant Hospice Jug Fishing Tournament.
2. Tournament will be held regardless of weather.
3. Mail entry deadline is three days prior to tournament date. Late registration will be held at the weigh-in site (Lake Point Landing) on the evening of the tournament from one hour prior to until tournament start time. Official start fishing time is 6:00 pm.
4. All State Game and Fish Commission Regulations will be enforced. Pay launching fees where applicable.
5. Teams may start fishing anywhere on Lake Eufaula at Tournament start time. Fishing prior to Tournament start time will result in disqualification.
6. No separation of team members allowed from start time until at least one team is in line with fish to be weighed. NO "ICED DOWN" OR "TURNED WHITE" FISH WILL BE WEIGHED IN BY ANY TEAM.
7. All teams MUST stop fishing at the end of official tournament fishing time (10:00 pm). At least one team member MUST be in the official weigh-in line with fish to be weighed by 11:00 pm. If there is no line, the weigh-in will officially close at 11:00 pm.
8. Winners will be determined by the total weight on NO MORE than Ten (10) catfish per team/boat. BIG/SMALL must be included in the 10 fish limit. If team brings MORE than 10 fish to the scales, team will be disqualified. A team/boat CANNOT win both the big and small fish prizes.
9. All catfish brought to the scales MUST have been caught during the official tournament hours on the day of the tournament by the team bringing fish to the scales.
10. Disorderly conduct and/or intoxication will not be tolerated and will result in disqualification.
11. A "team" consists of two (2) people in one (1) boat, however, any boat may have on board as many people as the boat is designed to carry safely. A team cannot fish more than 24 jugs with 1 hook per jug at any time during the tournament. Only JUG FISHING is allowed; no poles, rods and reels, trot lines, or bush hooks allowed.
12. Jugs or bottles should be marked for identification purposes. (Last name of both team members, etc.)
13. All jugs, bottles, cans, paper, and trash must be removed by each team member by the end of the tournament.
14. Type bait used at the teams discretion, as long as bait meets all State Game and Fish Commission regulations.
15. No fishing on any waters other than LAKE Eufaula South of buoy number 103.0. Teams MUST launch boats from Lake Point Marina site.
16. All State and Game Fish Commission regulations must have been observed throughout the tournament.
